1. Paarl Heights **£13.75**

Chenin Blanc (1)

South Africa. A crisp dry white with floral and citrus aromas. The palate is refreshing with guava and peach. A perfect all rounder. 12.5%

2. Sauvignon Blanc **£14.75**

Te HUA Valley (1)

New Zealand. Bursting with ripe gooseberry, citrus, melon and exotic aromas. It is a fresh and intense.

3. Petit Chablis

Cave de Vignerons (1) **£27.35**

France. Classical Chablis - lemon lime fruits with steely mineral undertones and a long clean finish. 12.5%

4. Pinot Grigio GPG (1) **£15.75**

Italy. Fresh, dry and delicate with gentle floral and citrus aromas. 12%

5. Eagles Point

Colombard Chardonnay (2) **£14.25**

Australia. An ideal aperitif and a fine accompaniment to seafood. 12.5%

6. Viognier La Joya Reserve (2) **£14.25**

Chile. Great depth of flavour with hints of apricots and ripe cherimoya, there is a very fresh on the nose, with good balanced acidity. 2008 14%

7. La Chaasse Shiraz-Grenache (2) **£14.75**

France. Fresh and lightly crisp with hints of strawberries. 12.5%

▪ RED WINE ▪

8. The Lizard Shiraz (D) **£13.75**

France. Produced from mature vines which produce a spicy and ripe balanced flavour. 14%

9. Tenta

Cabernet Sauvignon (c) **£14.75**

Chile 2010. An intense dark ruby wine, with cassis, blackberry and chocolate aromas. Medium bodied. 11.5%

10. Nostros Pinot noir (c) **£18.75**

Chile 2011. A light fragrant red, bright strawberry and raspberry fruits dominates a soft subtle palate. 14.5%

11. Chateau Buisson Bordeaux (c) **£15.25**

France 2009. A subtle classic with a good mineral balance with ripe red fruits and a round velvety palate. 13%

12. Las Moras Malbec (D) **£15.95**

Argentina 2009. Soft medium -full bodied wine with a ripe red fruit flavour and an elegant touch of smoked oak with vanilla. 13.5%

13. Prosecco Lunetta (1) **£18.95**

Light and deliciously fruity with hints of apples and peach on the nose and a fresh, softly sparkling palate

14. Camel Valley Brut (1) **£29.95**

Cornwall's award winning sparkling wine. Produced near Padstow. It is eloquent and refined with a delicate flavour.
